The itinerary

Day 1

Arrive in Marrakesh and explore the vibrant city. Relax in our exclusively-hired traditional Riad and meet the rest of the group before getting an early night in preparation for starting the climb of Mount Toubkal tomorrow.

In the morning we will be picked up from Marrakech and drive to Imlil valley (1740m) - the starting point of the trek to Mount Toubkal. Here, we will be met by our local team of guide who will lead you on the climb. You will have a welcome mint tea at a guesthouse before you start your hike. After around 2 hours of hiking we will stop for a delicious lunch in chamharouch shrine. Later on, we will continue walking uphill to Mount Toubkal base camp where we will stay for the night. Today's walk will take around 5 to 6 hours.

The next morning, we will have an early breakfast at base camp before starting the climb up Mount Toubkal for sunrise. The climb is uphill on cree and rocky ground. It usually takes around 3 hours to walk up. Once you get to the summit (4167m), you will get amazing views over the High Atlas Mountains. After a short break to admire the sunrise, you will walk back down via the same route to base camp where you will have lunch and relax. Overnight again at Mount Toubkal base camp. Today's climb will take around 6 to 7 hours.

On the last day, we will have breakfast and walk back down via the same route to Imlil where we will have lunch at a guesthouse before transferring back to Marrakech Airport/city centre. Today's hike will take 4 to 5 hours and the drive back to Marrakech will take 1.5 hours.
